SUNDAY

FOCUS: Pray for All Campuses and Global Partners

Praise: *Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths. Proverbs 3:5-6*

Repent: We confess that we do not always trust You with _____ ex. how “do” relationships in quarantine, on-going financial provision, the future impact of COVID-19, etc.

Ask: Pray and trust that our church body would _____ ex. continue thriving spiritually, relationally & financially, continue acknowledging the Lord in every decision, etc.

Yield: As a church body, we trust you to direct our paths in each “next step” that we are to take.

MONDAY

FOCUS: Family

Praise: *Trust in him at all times, O people; pour out your heart before him; God is a refuge for us. Psalm 62:8*

Repent: As a family, we confess _____ ex. lack of trusting You for each detail, lack of pouring out our hearts to You, lack of love, patience and kindness for each other, etc.

Ask: Help our family to find refuge in you for _____ ex. our extended time together, our physical, spiritual and emotional well-being, our finances, etc.

Yield: We yield our family to You to grow in dependence, trust and love for You and each other.

TUESDAY

FOCUS: Community, Neighborhood, Education

Praise: *Surely God is my salvation; I will trust and not be afraid. The LORD, the LORD himself, is my strength and my defense; he has become my salvation.*

Repent: We confess that we are afraid of _____ ex. others making us sick, finding what we need at the store, safety when our children return to school, etc.

Ask: Pray that our community, neighborhoods and schools would _____ ex. trust in the Lord for wisdom in how to proceed, not be afraid, know salvation through Jesus Christ, etc.

Yield: We trust the Lord to show us how to pray for and tangibly impact our community, neighborhood and schools.

WEDNESDAY

FOCUS: Government and Leadership

Praise: *Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we **trust** in the name of the Lord our God. Psalm 20:7*

Repent: We confess _____ ex. trusting in the government, trusting in our ourselves, etc.

Ask: Pray that our leaders would _____ ex. trust the Lord for wisdom in every decision, trust the Lord for financial provision, trust the Lord as Savior, etc.

Yield: We trust the Lord to help us pray for and tangibly support our government and leadership.

THURSDAY

FOCUS: Medical Personnel and the Sick

Praise: *I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I **trust**." Psalm 91:2*

Repent: We confess _____ ex. not believing that God is our refuge and fortress, not trusting in the Lord for every detail, etc.

Ask: Protect the caregivers, heal the sick and also _____ ex. be their refuge and fortress, draw them to Yourself, provide wisdom, provide ample equipment, medications & vaccines, etc.

Yield: We trust the Lord to help us pray for and tangibly support caregivers and the sick.

FRIDAY

FOCUS: Business and Economy

Praise: *When I am afraid, I put my **trust** in You. In God, whose word I praise - in God I **trust** and am not afraid. What can mere mortals do to me? Psalm 56:3-4*

Repent: We confess _____ ex. fear over struggling businesses, fear over finances, etc.

Ask: Help businessmen and employees to _____ ex. not be afraid during this difficult time, trust the Lord for provision & finances, trust the Lord for wisdom in how to proceed, etc.

Yield: We trust the Lord to help us pray for and tangibly support our businesses and economy.

SATURDAY

FOCUS: Media

Praise: *He lifted me out of the slimy pit, out of the mud and mire; he set my feet on a rock and gave me a firm place to stand. He put a new song in my mouth, a hymn of praise to our God. **Many will see and fear the LORD and put their trust in him.** Psalm 40:2-3*

Repent - We confess _____ ex. lack of "singing a new song" during this time, lack of thanks for what God is doing, grumbling, complaining, etc.

Ask - Open the eyes of the media _____ ex. to see You working in amazing ways, to fear the Lord, to trust You as Savior and Lord, to report accurately, etc.

Yield - We trust the Lord to help us pray faithfully that "*many (in the media) will see and fear the Lord and put their trust in Him*".
